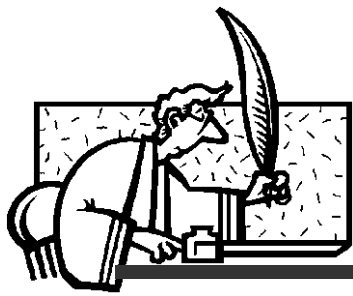

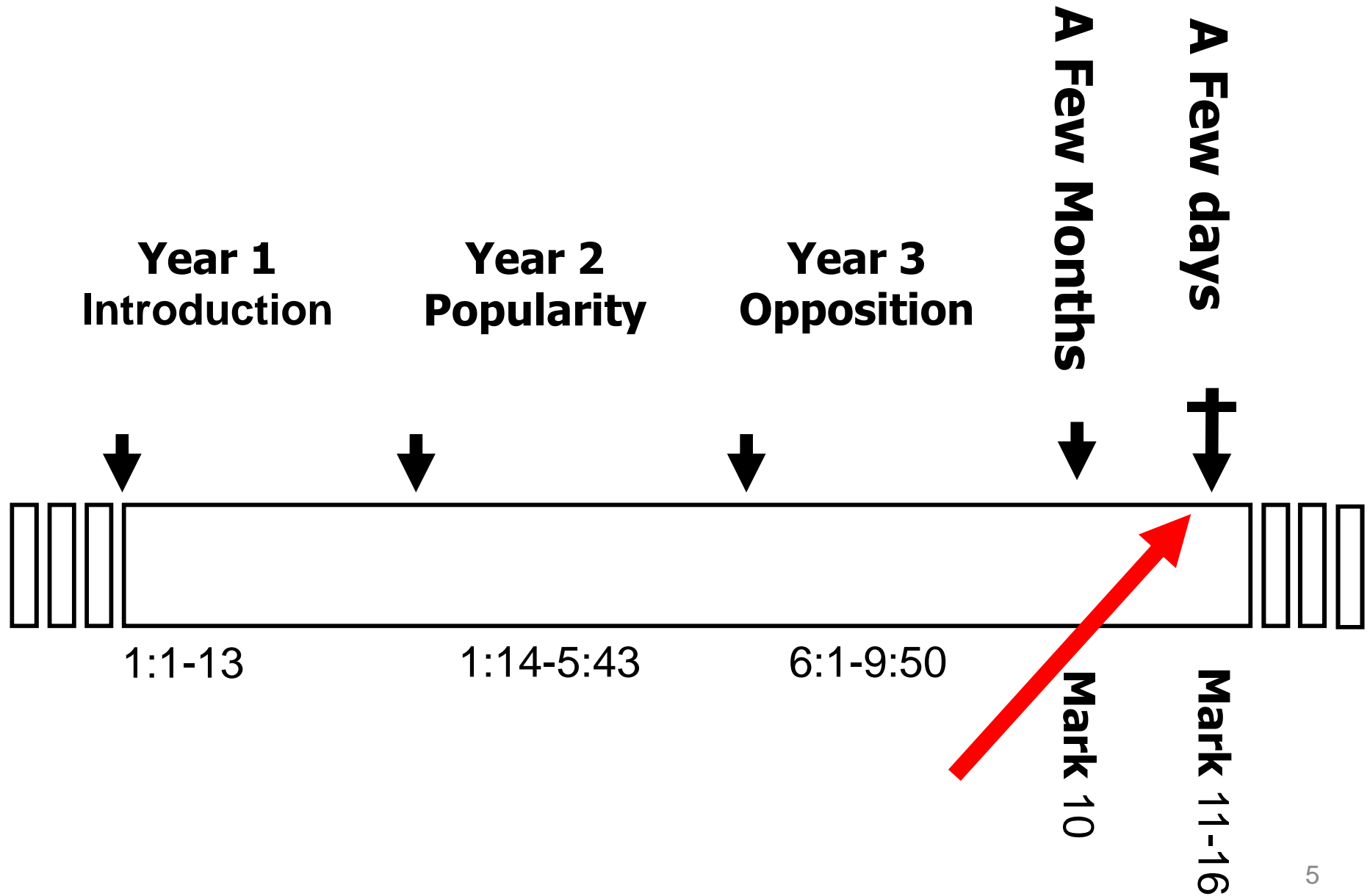

“Jesus Leaves His Mark”

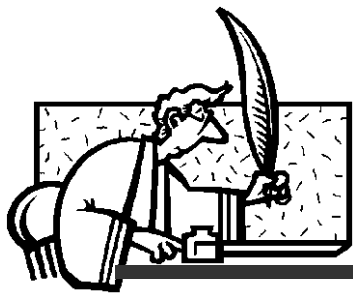
1. How do verses 1 - 2, and 10 - 11, act bookends for this passage? What significance might that hold for the events that are about to unfold?
2. If we were to say that the two key characters in this passage (besides Jesus) are the woman (v3) and Judas (v10) what contrasts do you see between them?
3. What other questions arise for you from this passage of scripture?



“Jesus Leaves His Mark”

a prelude to the passover

Mark 14:1-10



bookends - note contrasts

“Jesus Leaves His Mark”

v1-2 sly, arrest, kill, “deceit” (*chief priests and teachers*)

v3-19 reclining, pour, perfume, beautiful thing, not forgotten

indignation, accusation, harsh rebuke, (*disciples*)

v10 betray, “delight” give him money, watch for an opportunity ” (*chief priests and teachers, Judas*)



prelude to the passover

“Jesus Leaves His Mark”

- 1. Initiative** (*unforced service*)
- 2. Insight** (*a clear worldview*)
- 3. Investment** (*an heart for the future*)
